

Spinnaker Boat Prep Guidelines

Spinnaker Resorts is dedicated to conservation and protection of our local waterways and eco-systems. Please help us keep invasive species from being introduced into our protected waterways by following these steps before placing your boat and all equipment (including fishing equipment, waterskies, tubes, wake boards, etc.) in or near the water.

1. **Check** your boat, trailer, and equipment for visible vegetation, mud and pooled water. Please dispose of possible contaminant items such as dried vegetation in covered trash receptacles. Do not leave it on ground or in drains.



2. **Drain** all water holding compartments including live wells, bait wells, and bilge areas.



3. **Clean** your boat, holding compartments, trailer and equipment using proper washing techniques, ensuring all mud and residue is removed.
4. **Disinfect** your boat, trailer and all equipment using hot water over 140* or use a Potassium Chloride solution.



5. **Dry**, if possible allow all equipment to dry completely before putting it into the water.
